

Kelly O’Connell Weisfield is the Executive Director and a co-founder of the Sexual Violence Law Center (SVLC). Ms. O’Connell Weisfield directs and leads the achievement of SVLC’s mission, strategy, goals and objectives. She also provides programmatic guidance, reporting and oversight of its Sexual Assault Legal Services & Assistance program – which provides a statewide legal helpline and direct legal representation to sexual assault victims in King County on a broad range of issues including protection orders, housing, employment, immigration, Title IX, domestic relations, privacy and education rights. She provides legal consultation, training and resources on sexual assault issues to civil litigators, prosecutors, judges, legal advocates and service organizations throughout the state. She co-taught *Sexual Violence and the Law* at the University of Washington School of Law in 2007 and is an invited guest speaker to several symposiums and conferences on domestic and sexual violence, including those sponsored by the University of Washington, McGeorge School of Law (CA), Washington Association of Prosecuting Attorneys, Washington State Bar Association’s Young Lawyers Division, King County Family Law Task Force, and Office of Crime Victim’s Advocacy. She was appointed by the Governor as a member of the Supreme Court Dissolution Task Force from 2008-2009 and in 2006, had the privilege of serving on Washington’s Pattern Forms Subcommittee to develop the statewide protection order court forms, court staff handbook and related materials on Washington’s sexual assault protection order.

From 2005-2007, Ms. O’Connell Weisfield was a staff attorney for the Washington Coalition of Sexual Assault Programs. Prior to this, Ms. O’Connell Weisfield advocated for survivors of domestic violence and sexual assault in numerous capacities, including direct representation as a pro bono attorney with the Eastside Legal Assistance Program and legal advocacy with the Eastside Domestic Violence Project. She has been actively involved in public interest law for over 14 years, including volunteering for the Public Defender Association, the Immigrant Families Advocacy Project and the Free Legal Advice Centre in Dublin, Ireland. Ms. O’Connell Weisfield was formerly the Director of Legal Affairs for Expo Management, LLC and practiced privately at the law firm of Montgomery, Purdue, Blankinship & Austin, PLLC. Ms. O’Connell Weisfield graduated with honors from the University of Washington School of Law in Seattle, and also received her Bachelor of Arts magna cum laude in Society & Justice and Sociology from the University of Washington. Ms. O’Connell Weisfield was admitted to the Washington State Bar in 2000.
